2024 SAG Portfolio Planning Process

In 2024, SAG will focus on the Portfolio Planning Process

- A consensus-seeking process to discuss foundational issues to EE Portfolio Plan development with IL utilities
 - Utilities are responsible for planning, developing and implementing EE portfolios
 - Utilities are working on EE Plans for the next 4-year cycle -> 2026-2029
 - Each utility is required by statute to file a 2026-2029 EE Plan with the ICC for approval by March 1, 2025
- SAG Planning Process occurs once every 4 years
 - SAG has an advisory role, including an opportunity for participants to share feedback and ideas with IL utilities
 - Majority of Large Group SAG meetings will focus on Planning Process
 - The process concludes with individual utility negotiations with non-financially interested stakeholders
